REFEREE SUPERVISORS DUTY STATEMENT

Main Functions

- Co-Ordinate the Referees for all competitions where required.
- Report to the BBRA Committee.
- Is a paid position set down by the Board of Management

Referee Co-Ordination

- Co-Ordinate and manage the Referees for all competitions under the guidelines set down by the BBRA Committee
 - Ensure Referees take to the courts at their rostered time slots
 - Ensure time clock reflects the appropriate warm-up allowance and games start on time as fixtured, unless previous games run over time.
 - Find replacement Referees as and when required.
 - Resolve any disputes that arise during or after the game which relate to the game or score sheet which may not have been satisfactorily covered by the game Referee.
 - Report any serious concerns with regard to Referees, Coaches or Players to the BBRA Committee.

General points

- Recommend to the BBRA Committee any Referee that should be considered for either up-grading or down-grading.
- Report to the BBRA Committee any concerns regarding the on-court performance of any Referee (Appearance, Conduct & enforcing By-Laws / Competition rules).
- Report to the BBRA Committee any continued unsportsmanlike behaviour by officials, players or spectators
- Advise of any concerns regarding a Referees off-court performance
- Liaise with Club teams as required
- Required to referee if and when the need arises.
- Not permitted to play or coach while performing the Referee Supervisor duty.
- To act at all times in a professional and responsible manner which is not detrimental to the Association

- Identify and assists with the development and implementation of change initiatives to improve operations performance
- To advise the BBRA Committee of all other issues deemed necessary.
