## ORGANISATIONAL BACKGROUND

Basketball Ballarat Association is located in Ballarat where they provide indoor sporting opportunities to over 8,000 people weekly across the Mars Minerdome and Ballarat Sports and Indoor Centre. We are committed to providing a quality service to the local community with honesty and a professional image while promoting a healthy and active lifestyle for all abilities. In 2019 the Ballarat Sports and Event Centre will open after a \$24m upgrade to a Stage 1 redevelopment along with \$5m Stage 2 further upgrade.

## PRIMARY PURPOSE OF POSITION

Basketball Ballarat Association (BBA) is currently offering exciting opportunities for Physiotherapy/Remedial Massage/Myotherapy university students with a Sport Trainer's qualification to apply for Sport Trainer positions within BBA's Talented Player Development programs. This includes the Miners & Rush Senior Elite Teams, Youth League Teams and Juniors Teams.

Sport Trainers would report to BBA Head of Physiotherapist who would instruct students to assist or complete in general sports trainer roles and responsibilities working mainly with our State Development Program squads.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

We are currently looking for physiotherapy and myotherapy/remedial massage students to help with the talented player program. The hours vary as there are a number of programs that require assistance. Students should be comfortable performing the following tasks:

1. Strapping
2. First aid/RICE for injuries players acquire during training.
3. Exercise program supervision. The exercises will be prescribed by the BBA Athlete Development Coach & Physiotherapist.
4. Assisting injured players with their exercise program. This will be done under the instructions of BBA medical staff.
5. Occasional massage.
