JET Player Points – Junior A Grade Competitions

Basketball Ballarat will implement a point's cap for U12A, U14A, U16A & 19A domestic teams, based on the following:

- Representative players will be given a player points rating which will be in place for each season
- Points cap is calculated by club team per age group and will be 8 points for Under 12, 14 & 16s. Under 19s will have a cap of 12 points per team.
- All home grown players attract a one point deduction if they are selected in our local representative teams.
- A Category player transferring to another club will be allocated by the Competitions and Programs Committee. Although the player may nominate which club they wish to transfer to, the decisions will be based around what is best for the competitions. This process will be completed at an allocation meeting held the week after entries close
- A player on permit does not attract penalty points. There will be a limit of one permit player per age group at each club. Players need to abide by the Player Permit Policy to qualify.

Player Points Rating

- A player's points rating is defined by the highest level of Basketball they play in their age group currently and/or the previous season.

Category 1:	<u>3 POINTS</u>	Ballarat JET Blue Team. In case of under 12 representative teams see page 2 for descriptions
Category 2:	<u>2 POINTS</u>	Ballarat JET Gold Team. In case of under 12 representative teams see page 2 for descriptions. All out of town representative players will be allocated at a 2 point value, regardless of the level or team they are coming from.
Category 3:	<u>1 POINT</u>	Ballarat JET White/3 rd /4 th Team. In case of under 12 representative teams see page 2 for descriptions

- A player cleared to another club becomes home-grown after 2 Consecutive years.
- Each player will be categorised based on the normal representative team. A player who has filled in for a higher level team should not be categorised as a higher level player.
- A JET player who is not selected for the following year in the same age group will carry their points minus 1 point for that 12 months. If they are not selected for the next age group they will not carry any points
- If a current JET player is selected in the following years teams, moving up an age group then a deduction of 1 point will be applied for the Summer season. If a player is selected again but remains in the same age group they will hold their points value until the start of the Championship Season.

Procedure of Applying Points Values

- By the JET age group/gender coaching panel following the yearly Bendigo Tournament (Late January).
- The full list will be sent to the Elite Teams office for confirmation of points values.
- After endorsement by the elite teams office lists will be sent to the Basketball Manager to collate and publish to clubs.

In the case of Under 12 squads the following extra step will be applied due to the teams being altered on a tournament basis:

- Each coach in that panel will rank each child a 3, 2, 1 according to the allocation categories on page 1. An average value will be given to that player, with players that may fall in half value (1.5, 2.5etc) being confirmed as a group coaching group.

The aim of this is to provide a more even balanced A Grade setting for juniors and to promote club loyalty. Points valued players are eligible to play in competitions lower than A Grade, but may be subject to movement if the CPC or Grading Committee deem the player/team to be too strong for where they are placed.
