

2021 Championship Season Finals:

As the season draws to a close and finals are only a month away its time to turn our focus to some key information required for finals. As previously mentioned in communications the season will now see a two-week finals series with week one being 1 v 4 and 2 v 3. The winner of each match progressing to the Grand Final.

For our junior competitions; players are required to have played a minimum of four (4) games during the regular season to qualify for finals.

For our senior competitions; players are required to have played a minimum of five (5) games during the regular season to qualify for finals.

This spreadsheet will be updated after the final round of the season. As it currently stands as of 3rd of August the attached is the most up to date listings.

It is important to understand that players **must** be registered to the team to qualify a game played. Listing a player as a fill-in player will not count to the overall totals. If you are unsure if you have been listed as a fill-in player this can be identified by someone who has had to put their details into the iPad courtside prior to a match. If you have had to do this then that game is counted as a fill-in game. It is the responsibility of the team to ensure their team members are registered to their team correctly.

Basketball Ballarat have contacted players and team officials about “fill-in players” via email and messages multiple times this season. If they have been ignored to date there is nothing we can do to credit the games to your account.

What’s required of players/teams/clubs?

1. Check your qualification number via the documents provided. 4 games for a junior grade, 5 games for a senior game.
2. If you are required to lodge special consideration for finals as per our guidelines in the operations manual (page 15) please use the correct form which can be found via the above link.
3. If you are short of the minimum qualification games number you still have time to play and qualify.
